ARTISTS ELIGIBLE

The Georgia Watercolor Society 2011 Member Show is open to all artists 18 years of age and older. You need not be a resident of Georgia to enter. Your 2011 membership dues must be current

WORK ELIGIBILITY

All paintings must be original work in water-based media. No preprinted or computer generated images. Work done in a workshop or under classroom supervision is not permitted. All work must have been completed in the last two years and not previously exhibited in any GWS show. No Exceptions. For further clarification, refer to FAQ at:

AWARD SELECTION

Award winners will be determined after selected paintings have been reviewed by the juror. GWS anticipates more than \$1500 in merchandise and cash awards.

JUROR

Stan Miller, AWS will jury and judge the show. He will present a three-day workshop, October 12 - 14.

SALES

Georgia Watercolor Society will charge 50% commission on all sales. 40% will go to the Lyndon House Arts Center and 10% will be retained by GWS. Paintings not for sale must be marked NFS on the entry form.

EXHIBITION FACILITY

The Lyndon House Arts Center is operated by the Athens-Clarke County Leisure Services Department as a center of excellence for the benefit and cultural enrichment of youth and adults. Gallery exhibitions, art classes, festivals, workshops, art meetings, special events, and historic house museum aim to provide area citizens with a positive experience in the visual arts, encouraging them to appreciate the arts and to develop their creative talents.

PRESENTATION

All paintings must be framed in simple gold, silver or black metal or unadorned natural wood frames, not to exceed 3" in width, with plexiglass if glazed, no glass, ready for hanging with wire in place.

Work may be varnished or waxed before framing. Maximum frame size may not exceed 48" in either direction. No image size may be smaller than 8"x10." Water Media must be the dominant element. (no oils) Collage elements must be the original water media created by the artist. Work must be on paper, yupo, or watercolor canvas. Mats or liners, if any, must be white or light neutral color. Improperly framed pieces or those unsuitable for hanging will be returned.

If accepted, you will be asked to include a "Technical statement" as to the use of Materials and a brief statement about your painting. Limit to 75 words

PACKAGING

Proper packaging is imperative to protect your work. Improper packaging may result in damaged, returned or unopened shipment. **Wood crates will not be accepted. Packages sent with popcorn packaging will be returned.** Airfloat boxes are strongly recommended. Call 800-445-2580, and ask for GWS member discount.

AGREEMENT

No work accepted for the exhibition may be received after the final delivery date or withdrawn before the close of the exhibition. After an artist's work has been accepted, the artist may not substitute another work for the accepted one, or change the sale price.

METHOD OF ENTRY

DIGITAL AND EMAIL ENTRIES:

Entries must adhere to one of the following specifications for entry:

DIGITAL ENTRIES:

Create a high quality CD (200 pixels per inch minimum), digital image must be a JPEG. See newsletter for more info on digital submissions.

EMAIL ENTRIES:

Submit the digital file to GWS as an e-mail and send it to:

All emails will be acknowledged upon receipt. CDs will not be returned.

Do Not Submit a CD as well as an e-mail image.

Send one or the other, but **not both**. As soon as your information and entry form are received, a second e-mail will be sent confirming the receipt.

ENTRY FEES:

MEMBERS: \$20 for one entry; \$25 for two entries; \$30 for three entries.

If you are not a member for Georgia Watercolor Society and you would like to enter, please fill out the membership form and enclose it with your entry form adding \$30.00 for your membership fee. Non-members are not eligible for this Exhibition.

DELIVERY AND RETURN OF WORK:

All paintings accepted for exhibition must be shipped to arrive between August 9 - 12. Shipping instructions will be sent to those accepted.

Return shipment must be prepaid.

**PAINTING THE LANDSCAPE AND PORTRAIT IN WATERCOLOR
(AND EGG TEMPERA)**

BEGINNERS, WITH SOME BASIC EXPERIENCE, TO ADVANCED

STAN MILLER is a signature member and repeat award winner with the American Watercolor Society. He won the grand prize in the Watercolor Magic Magazine national painting competition in 2006. In 2004 he won first place in landscape in the Artist's Magazine National Painting Competition. In 2006 he instructed a workshop with Plein Air Painters of America in France. The French magazine, Pratique Des Arts, recently featured Stan in their December 2010 issue. In 2011 Stan will be conducting a workshop in Canada for the Canadian Federation of Artists. He continues to give workshops around the United States, Canada and Europe. For more information: www.stanmiller.net

In this workshop, Stan will demonstrate each morning. Throughout the workshop, he will visit and instruct each student individually. Stan will address the fundamentals of watercolor painting; color, watercolor technique, egg tempera technique, composition, and choosing a paintable subject based on one's skill level. How to approach the landscape and the portrait, using a variety of styles and approaches, from realism to impressionism to abstraction will be demonstrated and discussed.
